POLICIES, CLASS RULES AND REGULATIONS RECREATIONAL PROGRAM

CLASS RULES:

1. Please be on time for classes. If you are over 15 minutes late, please have a note from a parent or guardian explaining the reason why.
 2. Chewing gum is NOT allowed in class as it is unsafe to chew gum while dancing. The instructors will observe who is chewing gum and ask the students to dispose of their gum. However, it is fundamentally the student's responsibility and Fame Dance Studios Ltd. is not liable if a student is harmed or injured while chewing gum.
 3. Please do not wear any jewelry in class. Once again, it could be hazardous.
 4. Class attire is applicable to all classes and must be respected. Requirements are listed below: (all class attire can be purchased from Artistic Dance and Costume @780-872-7555//5010-50 street, Lloydminster). They also do mail orders. If class attire is not respected, a parent will be called to remind the student to wear what is mandatory and expected.

BOYS DANCE CLASS ATTIRE:

-ALL CLASSES - BOYS WILL WEAR LOOSE FITTING BLACK STREET CLOTHES AND THE FOLLOWING LIST OF SHOES:

- WHITE RUNNERS FOR HIP-HOP AND MUSICAL THEATRE
 - BLACK CANVAS BALLET SHOES WITH CRISS CROSS STRAPS FOR TINY TOTS AND JAZZ
 - 5-7 JAZZ/HIP-HOP COMBO: WHITE RUNNERS
 - 5-7 JAZZ/BALLET COMBO: BLACK CANVAS BALLET SHOES WITH CRISS CROSS STRAPS
 - 5-7 JAZZ/BALLET/HIP-HOP COMBO: WHITE RUNNERS
 - 5-7 TAP/BALLET/JAZZ COMBO: BLACK CANVAS BALLET SHOES WITH CRISS CROSS STRAPS, BLACK FLAT TAP SHOES
 - 6-8 TAP/BALLET COMBO: BLACK FLAT TAP SHOES, BLACK CANVAS BALLET SHOES WITH CRISS CROSS STRAPS
 - JAZZ/LYRICAL COMBO: TAN HALF SOLES (PIROUETTES)

GIRLS AND BOYS - WHAT TO WEAR FOR ACRO CLASS:

- GIRLS: TIGHT TANK TOP OR BODYSUIT WITH TIGHT FITTING SHORTS...BLACK PREFERABLE BUT ANY COLOUR IS FINE :)
 - BOYS: T-SHIRT OR TANK TOP, SHORTS
 - NO SHOES OR SOCKS
 - GIRLS: HAIR TIED BACK IN A PONY TAIL AND BANGS CLIPPED BACK

GIRLS DANCE CLASS ATTIRE:

Tiny Tots:

- Black school body suit – white tights - OR black tank top, black dance shorts or black leggings
- FIRST TERM - SEPT-DEC - pink canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps (ballet pink leather shoes are also fine if you can't find canvas in your size)
- SECOND TERM JAN-APR: (check the schedule as to if your class is a full year ballet/jazz or switches to tap)
- EITHER black patent tap shoes - OR - FULL YEAR BALLET JAZZ COMBO - keep pink ballet shoes
- hair should be pulled back and swept off face and neck in a bun or a pony tail.

4-7, 5-6, 5-7, 5-8, 6-8, 7-8 and 8+ Combo Classes:

*Jazz/Ballet Combo - black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts or black or pink dance skirt (optional) – white tights, pink canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps (ballet pink leather shoes are also fine if you can't find canvas in your size)– hair swept off face and neck and pinned or clipped up in a bun.

*Jazz/Hip-Hop Combo - black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts (optional black leggings) - black canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps – black footed tights required for Year End Show/Picture Day - optional to wear during classes– hair swept off face and tied back

*Ballet/Tap combo - black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts (optional black leggings and/or optional black or pink dance skirt) – white tights - pink canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps – black patent tap shoes - hair swept off face and neck and pinned or clipped up in a bun.

*Jazz/Ballet/Hip-Hop - black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts (optional black leggings) - black canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps– black footed tights required for Year End Show/Picture Day - optional to wear during classes– hair swept off face and tied back

* Tap/Ballet/Jazz - black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts or black or pink dance skirt (optional) – white tights - pink canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps – black patent tap shoes - hair swept off face and neck and pinned or clipped up in a bun.

* Tap/Ballet/Jazz/Hip-Hop - black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts or black or pink dance skirt (optional) – white tights - pink canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps – black patent tap shoes - hair swept off face and neck and pinned or clipped up in a bun.

* Jazz Tech/Tap Choreo - black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts or black or pink dance skirt (optional) – white tights - pink canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps – black patent tap shoes - hair swept off face and neck and pinned or clipped up in a bun.

Ballet: black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts or black or pink dance skirt (optional) – ballet pink tights – pink canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps (ballet pink leather shoes are also fine if you can't find canvas in your size)– hair swept off face and neck and pinned or clipped up in a bun.

Jazz: black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts (optional black leggings) – black canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps– black footed tights required for Year End Show/Picture Day - optional to wear during classes - hair swept off face and tied back

Tap: same as jazz except with black tap shoes – black Patent tap shoes - black footed tights required for Year End Show/Picture Day - optional to wear during classes - hair swept off face and tied back

Lyrical/Contemp: same as jazz except light tan footless tights, tan half soles (pirouettes)

Hip-Hop and Variety/Musical Theatre: street clothes and solid white indoor runners

9-12 or Pre-Teen/Teen Jazz/Lyrical Combo: same as jazz except light tan footless tights, tan half soles (pirouettes)

9-12 or Pre-Teen/Teen Jazz/Hip-Hop Combo: black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts (optional black leggings) – black canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps – pure white runners

9-12 or Pre-Teen/Teen Lyrical/Contemp Combo: same as jazz except light tan footless tights, tan half soles (pirouettes)

9-12 or Pre-Teen/Teen Ballet/Lyrical Combo: same as jazz except light tan footless tights, tan half soles (pirouettes)

9-12 or Pre-Teen/Teen Jazz/Lyrical/Hip-Hop Combo: black school body suit * ** – black practice shorts (optional black leggings) – black canvas ballet slippers with criss cross straps

13+ Jazz/Contemp Combo: same as jazz except light tan footless tights, tan half soles (pirouettes)

Teen/Adult classes: ask your teacher please

Modelling: please wear a suitable pair of heels or dress shoes

* **School Body suit:** please make sure to get your black school body suit with interchangeable clear straps **instead of black school body suit, student can wear black tight fitting tank top and black dance shorts or black leggings

* **Warm-up clothes:** any student is allowed to wear TIGHT FITTING dance sweaters, sweat pants, capris or Famewear to the beginning of any ballet, jazz, tap, or lyrical class. However, once the student is warm, they will be asked to remove these items to better see body lines.

5. The instructor has the right to expel a student from the class.

6. If there is a discipline or behavioural problem with a student, the parent/guardian will be contacted. If the problem continues, the director has the right to expel a student from the program with no refund of fees.

7. Only positive communication is allowed at Fame Dance Studios. We encourage all communication. However, negative or harsh tone towards staff or students will not be permitted from any client and repeated negative behaviour will result in the client being expelled from the program without any refund.

8. Attendance is crucial for all programs/performances. If any student misses 2 or more consecutive classes in any term or misses enough lessons or performance events to impede their progression and readiness for upcoming events, the instructor will suggest either a) private lessons to catch up at the student's expense or b) will exempt the student from any upcoming shows or events. As well, if you miss a class or think that you will be absent from a performance, please phone in to the studio to let us know. It is the PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to enquire if there were any handouts or information sent out to the class on the day/s the student was absent.

9. Parents/friends/relatives are not allowed to watch regular classes as this can be very distracting to the students. However, scheduled parent watches occur throughout the year so that all friends and family can come in to watch the students in their classes. Look for these on your dance calendars on our website.

POLICIES:

1. The deadline for withdrawing from a class and receiving a refund is during the first 3 weeks of classes. **If you withdraw during the first three weeks of lessons, you will receive a refund for all remaining classes but you will not receive back your registration fee or the cost of the first three lessons.** After this time, a refund will ONLY be issued if the reason is due to a medical problem and a doctor's note must be provided. A student is considered

enrolled in a class until the studio is notified in writing (letter or e-mail to info@famedancestudios.com by a parent/guardian and payment for classes will continue. **The registration fee is non-refundable.** Refunds will be issued within 4-8 weeks of the date the client notified/made the request to Fame in writing.

2. Any cancelled lessons during the year will be made up on another day during the dance season.
 3. There will be a \$45.00 charge added for any NSF cheques.

PAYMENT PLANS

At the time of registration, there are two payment plans available:

Payment Plan #1 – Full Payment

- a) You may pay in full at our **Pre-registration** and receive a 10% discount.
- b) You may pay in full at our **Fall registration** and receive a 5% discount.
- c) Costume fees are due at time of registration - you may post date this amount to Nov 1st.

Payment Plan #2 – Post-dated cheques

- a) You may pay with a maximum of 8 post-dated cheques at **Pre-registration** and receive a 5% discount. The first cheque must be dated during the month of the pre-registration you attend.
- b) You may pay with a maximum of 8 post-dated cheques at **Fall-registration**. However, there is no discount offered at **Fall registration** for post-dated cheques.

* **ALL POSTDATED CHEQUES MUST BE SUBMITTED AT TIME OF REGISTRATION.**

* Post-dated cheques are to be dated for the **1st of each month.**

c) Costume fees are due at registration - you may post-date this amount to Nov 1st of the dance season. Once costumes have been ordered, costume fees are no longer refundable. Tiny Tots in first term only do not need a costume fee. If they continue on to enroll in the second term or wish to enroll in full year, costume fees are due at 2nd term tiny tot registration.

*CONTINUED, UNPAID ACCOUNTS WILL RESULT IN THE STUDENT BEING EXPELLED FROM THE PROGRAM WITHOUT ANY REFUNDS.

LATE FEE POLICY:

* IF YOU HAVE ANY OUTSTANDING FEES IN ANY CATEGORY BY JANUARY 1ST OF THE DANCE SEASON THAT ARE NOT COVERED BY POST DATED CHEQUES THAT ARE NOT ALREADY IN FAME'S POSSESSION, YOU WILL BE CHARGED 5% PER LATE MONTH ON YOUR BALANCE OWING UNTIL ACCOUNT IS PAID.

* IF YOU HAVE ANY OUTSTANDING FEES IN ANY CATEGORY BY APRIL 1ST OF THE DANCE SEASON THAT ARE NOT COVERED BY POST DATED CHEQUES THAT ARE NOT ALREADY IN FAME'S POSSESSION, YOU WILL BE CHARGED 10% PER LATE MONTH ON YOUR BALANCE OWING UNTIL ACCOUNT IS PAID.

Recreational Program Outline

- The dance season runs from September to the end of April. The Year-end shows will be held at the end of April/beginning of May.

- Recreational students will all perform in our annual Year End Show.
- Recreational classes are offered in the following dance forms: classical ballet, jazz, tap, hip-hop, musical theatre and lyrical.
- A student in the recreational program does not need to take any mandatory classes.
- Recreational classes focus on the enjoyment of learning dance.
- Students in the recreational program are not usually entered into dance festivals or extra performances. However, if the instructor deems the class ready to perform at an extra performance, this will be recommended to the class.
- Students are strongly encouraged to practice at home.
- There will be scheduled parent watch nights during the year.

Costumes

- A costume is required for each choreography/dance taken by a student.
 - A \$55.00 (tiny tots) or \$75.00 (all other classes) costume fee will be collected at time of registration to assist in the purchase of costumes early in the season.
 - Once costumes have been ordered, costume deposits are not refundable.

Class Placement

- During the first 3 weeks of classes, a fully registered dancer may try other dance classes at no charge. After the first 3 weeks, a FINAL DECISION is required and payment for any additional classes that the student may wish to add is due at this time.
 - After the first three weeks, no further transfers will take place or be allowed.
 - Late registrations will only be taken if a proposed student is able to keep up with the pace of the class and full year tuition fees are required.
